







Fact Sheet

A wage subsidy is a financial incentive of up to **\$10,000** to encourage businesses to hire and retain new employees.

Employers can access a wage subsidy if they:

-  Have an ABN.
-  Have not previously received a wage subsidy for the same person.
-  Are not an Australian, state or territory government agency.
-  Complies with Australian employment standards.
-  Are open to The Personnel Group supporting the placement in the workplace.

Wage Subsidy Fact Sheet

A snapshot at available wage subsidies.



DSS WAGE SUBSIDY

UP TO \$1650 for employing a person registered with The Personnel Group.



RESTART WAGE SUBSIDY

UP TO \$10,000 for employing a jobseeker who is 50 years of age or over.



YOUTH BONUS WAGE SUBSIDY

UP TO \$10,000 for employing a jobseeker who is 15-24 years of age and is registered with a Transition to Work provider (The Personnel Group).



LONG TERM UNEMPLOYED

UP TO \$6500 for employing a jobseeker registered with The Personnel Group and has been seeking employment for 12 months.



INDIGENOUS WAGE SUBSIDY

UP TO \$10,000 for employing eligible Indigenous job seekers.



PARENTS WAGE SUBSIDY

UP TO \$6500 for a jobseeker who is a principal carer parent.
