



Graduate Program Overview

Graduates of *Personnel Futures* will emerge as highly skilled, confident, and compassionate allied health professionals equipped to deliver high-quality care, work in interdisciplinary teams, and drive innovation in healthcare delivery.

Graduates will have 12 months to experience working with a not-for-profit employer and gain experience working with diverse client presentations to ensure Graduates receive well-rounded clinical training. A centralised corporate services structure will ensure Graduates are educated not only in their chosen health pathway but are

given exposure to key business functions allowing them to fully understand how they connect to organisational objectives and other disciplines such as education and employment.

Program Goals

- Graduates will develop an understanding of the values and purpose of The Personnel Group and contribute to holistic community participation.
- Graduates will deliver services within a comprehensive service delivery model ensuring customers receive a high standard of care.
- Graduates will foster interprofessional collaboration and teamwork, working collaboratively with both internal and external stakeholders and a multidisciplinary team.

Graduates will have opportunities to develop their skills and knowledge in an area of personal interest.

Our program will differ slightly, depending on your area of study to ensure that what you are learning is relevant, however, there will be lots of opportunities to work with all of the employees within the Health team.



Our program focuses on 5 key areas

Aiming to boost your confidence and develop essential skills to ensure you grow into a strong clinician with The Personnel Group.

Orientation and Onboarding

- Comprehensive group orientation allowing you to connect and form friendships from day one.
- Introduction to Personnel Group's values and an opportunity to engage with the Executive team.
- Introduction to Health's service delivery model and systems we use.
- Introduction to the program's expectations, goals, and available support services.
- Introduction to Wellbeing Support
 Officer and HR team.
- Graduates will be provided with all required equipment including IT, Uniforms and connections to key personnel.



Mentorship and Supervision

- You will be assigned to your clinical lead who will support you through your graduate year and beyond.
- You will be assigned to a mentor within your site, who will provide daily support and advice and help you adjust to working with Personnel Group.
- Clinical supervision will be provided and scheduled into your calendars as per internship and competency requirements.
- Clinical primary and secondary supervision provided for psychology graduates as per internship requirements.
- You will meet with your clinical lead weekly who will provide feedback and guidance as required to support your clinical growth and completion of the graduate program.
- Your first 12 weeks will have a dedicated graduate check in, incorporating all the graduates to foster team building and connectiveness.

Training and Professional Development

- Dedicated training and professional development opportunities throughout the 12-month program.
- Supervision and professional development is delivered in line with internship and AHPRA requirements for both provisional psychology and OT

- graduates.
- Access to a resource library including videos, training, templates and more to support you in your new role.
- National Psychology Exam training and preparation, specially designed to support you in completing and passing your exam.
- A dedicated graduate program platform that will track and monitor your progress towards completion of the program.

Interprofessional Collaboration

Monthly peer review training with all members of our Health team to develop your interprofessional collaboration skills, and exposure to working within multidisciplinary teams.

Evaluationand Feedback

- Regular monthly progress meetings to assess your progress, clinical competencies, and professional growth. This will include internship reviews and requirements in line with 5+1 provisional psychology graduates.
- We conduct quarterly reviews for all team members across our organisation. It's a regular check-in with your manager to discuss how you are tracking with your KPIs and what support we can provide you. Our reviews also provide you an opportunity to discuss training opportunities and career pathways.

Your career continues with The Personnel Group after the graduate program

Our graduate program has been designed to support you in your first year in a clinical role, however your journey doesn't have to end here.

After you complete the graduate program, we will continue to support you with:

- Quarterly professional and career development review.
- Building your clinical skills with specialised training opportunities.
- Weekly reviews with your clinical lead.

- Monthly clinical supervision.
- Mentoring opportunities for new graduate students.
- A professional development allowance.
- Leadership development through our Growing Great Leaders program.
- An opportunity to research and present a personal passion project to the TPG executive and senior managers of our Health team.


Our Recruitment Process
