Requirements:

As part of the CPR course, you are required to complete the online pre-learning prior to attending the face-to-face element of learning. The online pre-learning is completed off-site. Learners should allow 5 hours in total to complete the required readings and assessments. Evidence of completion must be provided on the day of face-to-face practical learning.

Students wishing to undertake an update/refresher of their course must also complete the online pre-learning activities. A copy of a current HLTAID009 CPR certificate/competency card (or equivalent) will be required.

Completion of online pre-learning prior to the face-to-face session and evidence of completion must be provided on the day of face-to-face practical learning.

Assessment:

Each candidate must demonstrate skills in an environment that provides realistic in-depth scenarios and simulations to assess candidates' skills and knowledge. Simulated assessment environments must simulate real-life situations where these skills and knowledge would be performed, with all the relevant equipment and resources that a workplace or community environment would provide.
